

HENSALL CO-OP BRIGHT FUTURES SCHOLARSHIP

Application Form

Purpose

The purpose of the **Hensall Co-op Bright Futures Scholarship** is to provide post-secondary scholarships to students who have shown a career interest in agriculture or a field or trade that will advance rural communities and economies. Three scholarships of \$2,500 each will be awarded to students who are children or grandchildren of individuals who were:

- A member of Hensall Co-op as of March 1, 2024
- An employee of Hensall Co-op as of March 1, 2024
- Individuals who had a controlling interest in an entity that was a member as of March 1, 2024.

Awards

Up to three one-time \$2,500 scholarships are available. All scholarships will be paid directly to the recipients in August, provided that Hensall Co-op has received proof of acceptance to an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be accepted and have the intention of being, or already are, full-time students attending an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada (College or University).
- 2. Applicants must be majoring in agriculture or in a field/trade that will advance rural communities and economies.
- Applicants must be children or grandchildren of an individual who was a member of Hensall Co-op as of March 1, 2024, was/is an employee of Hensall Co-op as of March 1, 2024, or who had a controlling interest in an entity that was a member as of March 1, 2024.
- 4. Proof of acceptance or current attendance to an accredited post-secondary institution in Canada.

The Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation. Hensall Co-op will not award scholarships to applicants who are not qualified and reserves the right not to award a scholarship in a given year.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Demonstrated or expressed interest in a field of study that will support Canadian agriculture or a field that will advance rural communities and/or economies.
- 2. Student essay.
- 3. Academic standing.
- 4. Previous work with community organizations particularly those that support agriculture, rural communities, or rural economies.

Application Requirements

To be considered for this scholarship, applicants must complete an application and return it to Hensall Co-op (<u>marketing@hdc.on.ca</u>) by August 1, 2024. The application must include:

- 1. A completed application form. Only completed application forms will be considered.
- 2. An official transcript for the last two years of your schooling.
- 3. A one-page (< 500 words) statement stating the applicant's reason for applying, qualifications, and educational and career goals. We want to know how you plan to use your education to support Canadian agriculture and/or rural communities and their economies, as well as how you have supported your community.

All the items listed above must be submitted before the application will be considered.

Submission of Application Form

The application form is a fillable PDF file. Fill the form out electronically, then "Save a Copy". Note the application requires a signature. You may provide an electronic signature, or print the completed application, sign it, and either scan it as a PDF or mail the printed application to Hensall Co-op.

For the one-page statement, you may use the page included in this application form or attach a separate page.
