

# Harvest Instructions



- **We are operating with harvest hours** (Please check the [website](#) for weekly hours of operation)
  - Although we will be receiving harvest as usual, steps have been taken for both the safety of our employees and yourself.
  - Unfortunately, not all locations have services that allow business as usual. Some of our locations will be practicing a closed-door policy while others will allow customers to access our locations. The places where access is granted will only allow limited access and barriers will be set up for everybody's protection.
  - We will do our best through these times to service your needs. Our capabilities will be determined by the health of our valued employees – please be patient if there are delays.
  - Please self-screen – if you are sick or are under self-isolation **DO NOT** visit our location until you are clear to do so
  - Please follow the signage posted
  - We will be limiting access to various areas; a change in the way we do business but a necessary one
  
- **For quality checks**
  - There will be some different procedures in place to ensure the safety of our employees and growers.
  - Call ahead so you are prepared for the process. Grading will be done as usual with following exceptions specific to each location:
    - Some locations will have a pail set up outside that we ask you to fill when you arrive. Once filled, we ask that you ring the doorbell and take a step back to allow employees to pick up the pail for grading. If you wish to wait for results that is fine but ask that you physically distance yourself (2m) from other customers. If you wish to have the results sent to you, please provide us contact information.
    - Some locations will be allowing access into our buildings, but this access will be limited, and protective barriers will be in place for your protection. We ask that you maintain physical distancing while waiting for service.

  - Please follow signage and stay in your vehicle
