

Hensall Co-op is now introducing direct deposit as a new form of payment for your grain settlements. To set this up all we need from you is a void cheque and the following contact and banking information:

Please contact your IT department or Internet Service Provider (ISP) to ensure the following email address <u>donotreply@hdc.on.ca</u> is a member of your trusted domain. This will ensure emails concerning EFT payment details will not be considered spam or junk mail by your email server or ISP.

Going forward, should your banking information and/or contact information change please advise us as soon as possible.

What does this mean to you? Direct Deposit means no hold on funds deposited to your account. No longer will you have to wait for the cheque to arrive to deposit and get access to your money. <u>Please</u> allow 4 business days for deposit directly into your bank account.

Upon weigh out though a Hensall Co-op receiving location, you will receive an update email with your load (ticket) information.

- § Great for having a back-up of tickets, as paper sometime goes missing.
- § Great tool for those who share crop. Keep track of split loads.
- § Any concerns, questions or spilt errors may be addressed right away.



Corn

- Chinese buying is going to be key to our export out of US. Do they continue to find enough corn in the Black Sea region to keep them out of the US.
- Ethanol margins remain strong and will help to drive domestic demand should keep values supported.





Soybeans

- South American crops size, crop has gone into the ground in good shape. Do we start to see private analyst raise crop production?
- Chinese demand over next 6 months is going to be key if we are going to get an increase in usage out of China. Early indications are they might struggle to meet last years number for crush production.
- Crush margins are driving crush in the US on the back of high oil prices. If crush margin fade at some point that will be negative to the soybean complex.

FOB Farm Grain

- With strong ethanol and soybean crush margins basis coming out of harvest could firm as market will try and pull bushels from the bins.
- Flat price target orders will be key going forward as values might pop and then push back down quickly. There is a lot of grain out there that will fill the market up quickly if cash targets are hit.



Marketing Tools

- **Ø** Marketing is a tough job. It's always a trade-off between what the market offers and what you need or want. It's all about managing your risk.
- **9** Gain Knowledge on the diverse marketing tools available to market your commodity. There are more options then just cashing to the market and or storing at harvest. Call your local Hensall Co-op Grain Marketer to discuss options that fit your operation.
 - **Ø** Forward Contracts
 - **Ø** Basis Contracts
 - **Ø** Deferred Payment
 - **Ø** Extend time horizons. Sell by flat pricing carries for those with on farm storage.
 - 6 Hensall Co-op, IP Soybeans program. Add a premium to your product!
- **Ø** Involve your spouse, business partner etc. 2 or 3 heads are better than one.
- **Ø** Know your cost of production. This helps to know where to start selling for a profit. Write down a plan on paper. Allow for some flexibility.
- **Ø** Devote a few minutes each day to keep up with the markets. Daily news headlines more and more are behind the moves of the day.
 - **Ø** Check out http://www.hdc.on.ca/grain-marketing.html link to monitor prices.
 - **Ø** Off Farm Bid sheet, published on Friday after the close, sent in e-mail format.
 - **Ø** Daily market updates available via e-mail, text message, and posted to Twitter.
- **Ø** Sell incrementally. Example break each crop into 5 chunks.
 - **Ø** This takes away the pressure of trying to hit "the High"
- **Ø** Use/Place open orders to capture values when they present themselves.
 - **Ø** If markets happen to go on a run while your on vacation or unable to monitor daily prices.
 - **Ø** Prices might only "hit" very briefly, helps to maximize the sometimes short opportunity to forward book at the price wanted.
